7/2015/5247 – Fell Foot Park

The Chair briefed the Council and members of public on the history of this application and then presented the Council's comments that had been sent to LDNPA. The Clerk had spoken to Ben Long that day and he asked if we would like to change our comments as they could be read either way (for or against).

4 members of the public spoke to the Council about their concerns over this development. The main reasons being:

Noise levels
Glamping Pods
New Entrance opposite Atkinson Court
Boat House being used for commercial events
Bus stops/Coaches

Mr Cullen (member of the public) had already contacted the Council with his concerns and had received a copy of our comments from LDNPA. He asked the Council to withdraw our comments and re-submit them but with stronger emphasis about the concerns.

After the public had left, the Council decided to re-draft the comments in order that the LDNPA could not selectively interpret them as totally in support. The concerns would be expressed first with some of them strengthened. The Chair will draft something and circulate before sending to the Clerk for submission.
