Eligibility

- At least 18 years old.
- A British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any member state of the European Union.

Meet at least one of the following four qualifications:

- You are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the Staveley-in-Cartmel Parish in which you wish to stand from the day of your nomination onwards.
- You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in Staveley-in-Cartmel during the whole of the last 12 months.
- Your main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the day of your nomination has been in Staveley-in-Cartmel Parish.
- You have lived in Staveley-in-Cartmel Parish or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your nomination.

To Apply

Submit your name and contact details together with information on what you could bring to the role and why you would like to be a Parish Councillor to the Parish Clerk by letter or email by 1st February 2022. Candidates will be considered for co-option at the next Parish Council meeting on 7th February 2022.
